EIC contd...

- Established in 1964 by Govt. of India under section 3 of Export (Quality Control & Inspection) Act, 1963
- Objective is to ensure sound development of export trade of India through quality control and pre shipment inspection.



Main Functions of EIC

- To advise central government on the measures for sound development of export trade through quality control and inspection
- To draw up programmes for quality control and inspection of commodities
- To undertake such responsibilities as are assigned by GOI from time to time





Powers conferred under Act


- Notify- To subject commodities to compulsory pre shipment inspection
- Establish or Recognize-To specify the type of quality control or inspection that will be applied to such commodities
- Specify Standards- To establish, adopt or recognize specifications for the commodity
- To prohibit the export of the notified commodity unless it satisfies the conditions relating to quality control







- Established in 1966 by the Central Govt. under section 7 of the Act
- Field organizations of EIC for implementing the measures and policies of Govt. of India / EIC
- 5 in numbers, with HQ at Delhi, Mumbai, Chennai, Kochi & Kolkata
- Operate under technical and administrative control of EIC
- Backed by state-of-art laboratories and sub-offices
